AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WHITE HOUSE, TENNESSEE AMENDING THE MUNICPIAL CODE TITLE 6 LAW ENFORCEMENT CHAPTER 1 POLICE AND ARREST

Whereas, the Board of Mayor and Alderman desire to update the Municipal Code regarding age requirement in the Police Department;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE Board of Mayor Alderman that the White House Municipal Code Title 6 <u>LAW ENFORCEMENT</u>, Chapter 1 <u>POLICE AND ARREST</u> be amended from the Municipal Code as follows:

TITLE 6:

LAW ENFORCEMENT.

CHAPTER 1:

POLICE AND ARREST

SECTION:

6-108 *Amendments are made in bold, italics, and underlined text.

6-108. <u>Police officers--age requirements</u>. No person shall be employed in the police department as a uniformed police officer, on a full-time, part-time or reserve capacity until such individuals attains the age of twenty-one (21) eighteen (18).

This ordinance shall become effective upon its final reading and adoption by the Board of Mayor Alderman, and publication, the public welfare requiring it.
