1. Call to Order

Meeting was called to order at 7:00pm by Chairman Bibb.

The Board watched a video of when the violation occurred. Tavern 76 owner said that all their employees are ABC certified and that he was disappointed that this happened. The employee that committed the violation was put on a two week suspension.

- B. Consideration of revocation of the beer permit issued to Sudden Service located at 3150 Hwy 31, with an off-premises permit.

The Board watched a video of when the violation occurred. Representative from Sudden Service corporate office explained that the employee that committed the violation was immediately terminated due to his actions. She also mentioned that after doing their own investigation they were able to determine that this particular employee was using his own birthdate for many beer and cigarette transactions instead of actually verifying the purchaser's date of birth.
